Article 400.00 Umpires:

401.0 Official Uniform:

401.01 Cap: Plate and Field fitted navy caps with ASA white letters trimmed in blue.

401.02 Shirt: ASA Umpire Polo with ASA Letters (Powder Blue #130).

401.03 Pants: ASA approved long navy pants, black belt, black socks and shoes.

401.04 Misc. Equipment: Ball and strike indicator, plate brush, and navy ball bag.

401.05 Safety Equipment (Fast Pitch): Face mask with throat guard and other protective equipment as applicable.

402.00 General Requirements to Umpire:

402.01 Non Certified Umpire:

-
1. A current-registered umpire member in good standing.
 2. Passed the umpire exam. Score 90% on Umpire Rules Test.
 3. **Passed the ASA Background Check**
 4. Owns one or more Official Umpire Uniforms

402.02 Certified Umpire:

1. **Meet all requirements listed in 402.01, and, in addition:**
 - A. Attend the current year's State Rules Clinic or National Umpire School.**
 - B. Be approved by their KASA Region Commissioner.**

403.00 State Umpire Rules Clinic and School:

403.01 State Rules Clinic and School - Held in conjunction with the Kansas ASA Spring Meeting and Awards Banquet.

403.02 State Rules Clinic - Open to all registered umpires in good standing.

403.03 State Umpire School - Consisting of on field training in positioning, mechanics, and rules clinic. The school will be limited to fifty (50) umpires based on registration in each region.

403.04 ASA Umpire School: - Open to currently registered umpires in good standing.
